**SeQual Technologies Tees Up to Support Carlsbad Teen's Effort to
Raise \$1 Million for Children's Heart Foundation**

*Third Annual Mac Kline Golf Classic Founded by
Teen Born with Congenital Heart Defect*

SAN DIEGO – SeQual Technologies Inc., which develops oxygen systems known worldwide for their reliability, quality, revolutionary design and economy, announced today that it will be making a \$3,800 donation to the Third Annual Mac Kline Golf Classic to support research on preventing congenital heart defects.

MacKinzie “Mac” Kline, 15, is a top-five rated amateur golfer among her age group. She was born with a congenital heart defect that results in low amounts of oxygenation throughout her body. She began using SeQual’s Eclipse Oxygen System on the golf course in 2006 so she could continue competing. In addition to amateur tournaments, Kline has approval to use the Eclipse in Lady’s Professional Golf Association events, the first such approval for use of an assisting device ever offered by the LPGA. The Eclipse, about the size of a child’s backpack, is the most powerful portable oxygen system on the market for use at home, during travel, or in recreational pursuits. It supplies patients with 3 liters per minute of oxygen, 275% more than its nearest competitor.

The Children’s Heart Foundation raises funds to support research towards discovering the causes of as well as improving the methods of diagnosing, treating, and preventing congenital heart defects.

“MacKinzie Kline is an inspiration to SeQual and to all oxygen dependent patients,” said Jim Bixby, SeQual CEO. “She has shown that she has the determination to overcome adversity that few teen-agers - or adults - can imagine. We’re pleased to help in any way we can.”

“Thanks to SeQual and everyone else for contributing to my cause,” said Kline. “The Eclipse has been especially helpful because of its portability and size. It lets me concentrate on hitting the fairway instead of monitoring my oxygen supply.”

The golf classic will take place Friday, April 6, 2007 at the La Costa Resort & Spa in Carlsbad, California. Last year’s event attracted sports celebrities Drew Brees, Marcus Allen, and Randy Jones, among others.
