**SeQual Strengthens Ties With Providers,

SAN DIEGO - SeQual Technologies Inc., which develops oxygen systems known worldwide for their reliability, quality, revolutionary design and economy, announced today that it has entered into a vendor agreement with The MED Group, an association of home medical equipment (HME) dealers. The arrangement gives SeQual enhanced access to The MED Group members who will be driven to SeQual's products based on The MED Group's recommendation, marketing programs and contracted pricing.

"The MED Group is a good fit for SeQual's line of home oxygen products," said Stu Novitz, SeQual's North American sales manager. "Our flagship product, the Eclipse®, advances the way the industry can do business," said Novitz. "And with The MED Group, we are dealing with an organization that is dedicated to showing their members how they can expand and streamline their business by offering a high percentage of their patients a true single-source, seamless oxygen concentrator like the Eclipse."

In August of 2006, SeQual launched its Eclipse Oxygen System into the home healthcare market. The Eclipse is the most powerful portable oxygen concentrator (POC) available and is the only option available that offers the patient both pulse and continuous flow of oxygen on AC, DC and battery power. Other POCs rely solely on pulse dose oxygen, a mode not traditionally recognized by the clinical community for 24/7 use. Under the new agreement, The MED Group's 235 providers across the nation will now have access to the Eclipse as well as SeQual's Integra E-Z series of stationary concentrators.

Kelly Riley, director of The MED Group's National Respiratory Network, said SeQual's products offer a unique financial advantage to The MED Group providers.
